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### Portrait Painting Atelier Old Master

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A self-portrait is a representation of an artist that is drawn, painted, photographed, or sculpted by that artist. Although self-portraits have been made since the earliest times, it is not until the Early Renaissance in the mid-15th century that artists can be frequently identified depicting themselves as either the main subject, or as important characters in their work.

Oil Painting During the 17th Century. Seventeenth century painting in oils included several differing schools. (1) The dramatic, even theatrical European-wide Baroque style practised by history and mythological narrative painters like Peter Paul Rubens (1577-1640), Diego Velazquez (1599-1660); (2) A quieter Dutch Baroque school of easel-painting, known as Dutch Realism (1600-80).

Jean-Honoré Fragonard (French: [ʒɑ̃ onɔʁe fʁaɡɔnaʁ]; 4 April 1732 - 22 August 1806) was a French painter and printmaker whose late Rococo manner was distinguished by remarkable facility, exuberance, and hedonism. One of the most prolific artists active in the last decades of the Ancien Régime, Fragonard produced more than 550 paintings (not counting drawings and etchings), of which ...
